

Now's the time to help them all!









The plants make the colours.</p> <p><b>Fun fact!</b> There aren't any fish in this river!</p>	 <p><b>Crooked Forest</b></p> <p>This forest is in Poland. It is a strange forest because all the trees are curved, not straight. People don't know why. Some say it's because of snow.</p> <p><b>Fun fact!</b> There are 400 curved trees in this forest!</p>
 <p><b>Nazca Desert</b></p> <p>This desert is in Peru. The floor of this desert is rock. There are lots of big drawings in this desert. They're called the Nazca Lines.</p> <p><b>Fun fact!</b> There are more than 70 drawings, including monkeys and birds!</p>	 <p><b>African Savannah</b></p> <p>This savannah is in Africa. There are only two seasons here: the wet season, when it rains a lot, and the dry season, when it doesn't rain.</p> <p><b>Fun fact!</b> Half of Africa is savannah!</p>



- Dolphins mainly eat fish.

**FACT**  
There aren't any Baiji River dolphins in the world today. They're extinct!

**Bottlenose dolphin**  
It's the most common dolphin and it lives in tropical oceans. It looks happy because it's always smiling. **COOL!**

**Amazon River dolphin**  
It lives in South America. Sadly, there aren't many Amazon River dolphins. It is endangered because of pollution, fishing nets and fishing boats.

**Striped dolphin**  
It lives in tropical oceans. It's blue and grey. And it can jump high and turn around in the air. **WOW!**

**A lot of dolphins are endangered. We need to protect them, especially river dolphins.**
