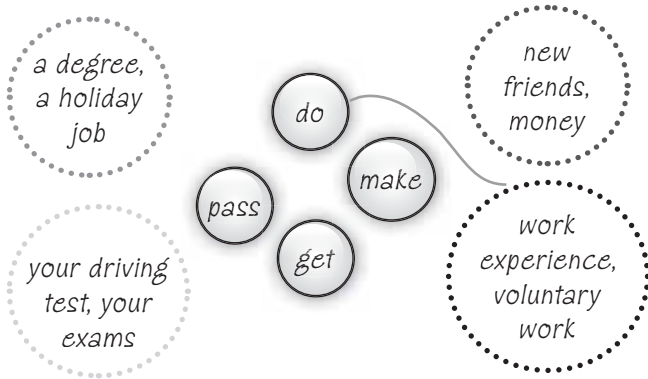

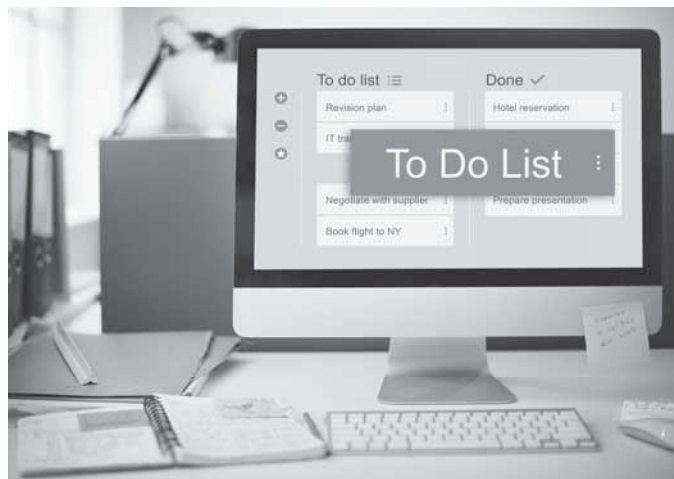

SO YOU WANT TO BE A PROFESSIONAL?

So you're talented but are you **dedicated** enough to your hobby or sport to become a professional?

We spoke to two teens who are working hard to turn their **passion** into a future career.

WINSTON GEORGE



This September I'll be starting at the Royal Ballet School in London. They only take 20 new students every year and I'm going to be one of them. I still can't believe it!

I'm different from other students because I only started ballet at 14, two years ago. Before that I was a hip-hop dancer. It was my PE teacher who made

me try ballet – I didn't want to go to my first lesson! But I loved it and now my goal is to become a professional dancer. At the school I'll be dancing for at least four hours every day and I know it will be difficult at first, but I'm determined to do well.

The biggest challenge for me will be the *pas de deux* – dancing with a partner – because I haven't had much practice. You sometimes lift your partner over your head and you have to be strong. I've got the strength but I'm not very tall for my age. I hope I'll grow another five centimetres at least by the time I'm 18!

FEMI WILSON



I live in London, but my dad is Brazilian and I started Capoeira when I was eight. I love it, in fact I'm a bit **obsessed** by it!

I sometimes practise for 4–5 hours a day. I want to be a

champion and start my own Capoeira school one day, but at the moment my mum wants me to prioritize studying for my GCSEs! I know she's right and I need to get some **qualifications** but I'm competing in the European championships in September so I need to train.

Next year I'll be 16 and I hope I'll be studying in São Paulo with a famous *Mestre* (Capoeira master), but I don't know if he's accepted me yet. I'm small and slim, like my mum, and sometimes people are surprised that I have such a good **level**. The Mestre said I needed to improve my singing – yes you need to sing in Capoeira, too – so I'm going to work very hard on that over the summer.
