Key structures: Present Simple



Let's look at the following examples:

- He gets up (at 5 o'clock in the morning).
- She goes to school by car
- She doesn't (have breakfast).
- Does he/she (have breakfast) in the morning?
- Yes, he/she does.
- No, he/she doesn't.

We use the present simple to talk about things that we do frequently (like our daily routines)



1. Affirmative form. We add "s" or "es" to the verb.

She **gets** up early in the morning.

He **walks** the dog every day.

She **goes** to the park after school.

Have is an irregular verb that changes its form when used in the third person of singular (he/she/it)

He **has** breakfast at 7 o'clock.

She **has** a shower at night.

2. Negative form. We use "does not" or "doesn't".

She **doesn't** get up early in the morning.

He **doesn't** go to bed before 10 pm.

3. Interrogative form. We use "does"+ subject (he/she/it).

Does he get up early in the morning?

Does she play football on Sundays?

4. When answering questions in the present simple we use:

Yes, he/she does.

No, he/she doesn't.
