Reading T/F (with explanation from text)	Unit 3, p38, ex 4	Unit 3, p32, ex 4	Tell students that they must quote the relevant information from the text to justify their answer.

Reading Vocabulary Find words in the text which mean... <p>Use of English m/c cloze texts</p>		<p><u>3 options</u> Unit 3, p29, ex 8 Unit 3, p36, ex 2</p>	<p>Although there are few multiple-choice cloze sentences, there are texts with three or four multiple-choice options, which could be used for practice of the same skill by focussing on specific sentences.</p>

<p>Writing A problem–solution essay</p>	<p>Unit 3, p44–45, exs 1–6</p>	<p>Unit 3, p35, exs 1–4</p>	<p>This genre does not appear in the current 2025 model, but it is good practice to be prepared for other genres which may appear. Ask students to write a composition of between 120 and 160 words.</p>
