Useful strategies for the Catalan PAU exam





The exam has three sections:

Bloque A

Listening comprehension (3 points: 0.375 points for each correct answer. Wrong answers will be penalised by deducting 0.125 points. There is no penalty for unanswered questions.)

• One long listening dialogue with 8 multiple-choice questions each with 4 options a-d.

Bloque B

Reading comprehension (**3 points**: 0.5 points for each correct answer. Up to 0.3 points might be deducted from the total mark for lack of intelligibility in the answers provided.)

• Six open questions including inference and paraphrasing questions.

Bloque C

Writing (4 points)

• Two essay prompts to write a composition. You choose <u>ONE</u> of the options. Your answer should be 125–150 words long. There is no specific penalty for exceeding 150 words nor will you receive more points for exceeding 150 words.

You have **90 minutes** to complete the exam.

2) General strategies

First, let's look at some general strategies which apply to all parts of the test:

- Always read the questions carefully: this will save you time and help avoid mistakes.
- In general, you should attempt to answer all parts of the test, but remember that incorrect answers will be penalised in the listening test. In the Writing section you must choose <u>ONE</u> of the two options.
- Check your answers carefully after completing each section. It can often save you lost marks.
- Make sure your handwriting is legible and your answers are clearly written or indicated.
- Watch the clock! Don't spend too much time on one section or else you may not complete the entire exam.
